King :

Supreme ruler over the kings of the earth. He represents Himself- Lawgiver, Judge, Ruler (2Sam 7:16; Psalm 89:20-29; Isa 11:1- 16; Jer 33:19-21) He was born a king (Mat 2:2; Lk 1:32) He is King of the Jews (Mat 2:2) He died as a king (Mat 27:37)	He is Head of the church (Eph 1:22) He is Head over every power and authority (Col 2:10) He is coming again as King (Zech 6:11-13; Rev 19:16) He is Eternal King (2Sam 7:16; Isa 9:6; Psalm 89:36)

DISCUSSION:

*The purpose of Jesus is to get man out of hell and into heaven.
The purpose of the Holy Spirit is to get Jesus out of heaven and into man.*

How To Receive Jesus Christ As Savior

All of mankind have sinned (Rom 3:23).

God cannot look on or be in the presence of sin. Therefore, sinful man cannot live with God unless his sins are atoned for and washed away (1Jn 2:2).

Jesus paid the penalty for man's sins by dying on the cross because He loves each person and wants each to be in heaven with Him (Jn 3:16; 1Cor 15:3; Rom 5:8).

Eternal life with God is a free gift (Rom 6:23).

Believe on Him, that He died for your sins and was raised from the dead.

Ask God to save you by confessing Jesus as your Savior and Lord and receive Him (the Holy Spirit of God) into your heart (Rom 10: 9-13).

You are now a believer, born-again (spiritually) as a new creation, now a child of God, and brought into the Kingdom of God (2Cor 5:17; 1Pet 1:3).

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ. 2 Cor 5:18
